




We are starting to learn about time. Today your assignment is on Google Classroom. I have also attached a blank clock if you wish to print it and make your own at home.

Each of you have a Soil assignment in Google Classroom. This will probably take about 3 days to complete. Take your time and pace yourself as this is your major task this week.







FLIPGRID


Collect one soil sample from outside and describe it by size, texture, and color.









